Jaime Harrison critical of Senator Graham's decision to block the Mueller bill

COLUMBIA, S.C. – Yesterday Lindsey Graham had two opportunities to champion bipartisan legislation, and he blew them both because President Trump and Fox News didn't approve. He voted against the bill to reject the emergency declaration, and he singlehandedly blocked the Senate from considering the House resolution to make the Mueller report public. The House passed the Mueller bill 420-0—a rarity in today's political climate. Yet everyone agrees that after two years and millions of dollars, the American people deserve to know what Mueller's team learned.

The Senator's actions shouldn't surprise us. Even though he is a co-sponsor of the bill to protect Robert Mueller from being fired, Senator Graham refused to move it through the Judiciary Committee.
